<p><b>Requested Action or Motion:</b> Move to adopt a resolution declaring paramount public purpose for the provision of disaster relief services by the City within gated communities due to Hurricane Irma.</p>	
<p><b>Summary Explanation &amp; Background:</b></p> <p>Throughout the State of Florida Hurricane Irma has caused extensive damage to trees and vegetation that requires timely and efficient clean-up by the local governments. The attached resolution declares that the expenditure of City funds for removal of vegetative and tree debris within gated communities by the City serves a paramount purpose due to Hurricane Irma. Currently, the City provides emergency services and removes yard waste from the gated subdivisions. A similar resolution was adopted in 2004 after Hurricane Charley in order to facilitate debris clean-up throughout the entire City.</p>
