<p><b>Requested Action or Motion:</b> Review draft letter to lakefront homeowners, including additional information, and provide input.</p> <p>Over the years the City has had various lake shoreline planting programs at different levels of intensity and resource commitments. Most recently, the LAB proposed a planting program to City Council that included the city subsidizing the cost of the plantings and installations along the lakeshores. After discussion, the City Council directed that the program be scaled back and reformatted into an educational program about the benefits of proper vegetation planting along the lakefronts that would be a benefit to the City's goals for improving the Lakes. City staff has drafted an educational letter to residents along the lake that encourages them to install these plantings and assists them in moving through the process.</p>
