Water Treatment Plant # 4

Address: 801 North Thistle Lane, Maitland, Florida 32751

Permitted Capacity: 1.44 MGD

PWS Identification No. 3480203

Water treatment consists of aeration, disinfection and fluoridation with infrastructure generally including two (2) ground storage tanks (250,000 gallons each),

Cascade aerators

Sodium Hypochlorite, Fluoride and corrosion inhibitor pumps

Generator

Ground water wells #4 and #4A

And associated valves, controls and appurtenances

Water Treatment Plant # 5 (Wymore Road)

Address: 550 N. Wymore Road, Maitland, Florida 32751

Permitted Capacity: 1.76 MGD

Water treatment consists of aeration, disinfection and fluoridation with infrastructure generally including one (1) ground storage tank (350,000 gallons)

Cascade aerators

Chlorine, Fluoride and corrosion inhibitor pumps

Generator

Ground water wells #5 and #5A

And associated valves, controls and appurtenances

Water Treatment Plant # 6 (Keller Road)

Address: 361 N. Keller Road, Maitland, Florida 32751

Permitted Capacity: 3.6 MGD

Water treatment consists of aeration, disinfection and fluoridation with infrastructure generally including two (2) ground storage tanks (750,000 gallons each)

Cascade aerators

Chlorine, Fluoride and corrosion inhibitor pumps

Generator

Ground water wells #5 and #5A

And associated valves, controls and appurtenances

Anticipated Regulatory Monitoring and Reports

Regulatory monitoring and reports are required by the following agencies:

- Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP)
- United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA)
- Florida Department of Health (FDOH)
- St. Johns River Water Management District (SJRWMD)

The FDEP and USEPA “Drinking Water Monitoring Requirements” including monitoring frequency for Maitland are included in Page 2 of 2 of Exhibit B.

Additional monitoring requirements are as follows:

SJRMMD:

- EN50 – every 6 months
- EN51 – well flow meter calibration – due every 10 years (next due in 2026)

FDOH:

- FLOSS Report (Fluoride) – monthly

USEPA additional requirements:

- UCMR4 - Unregulated Contaminant Monitoring is required for groundwater systems serving over 10,000 persons.

FDEP additional requirements:

- Dalapon – sample quarterly
